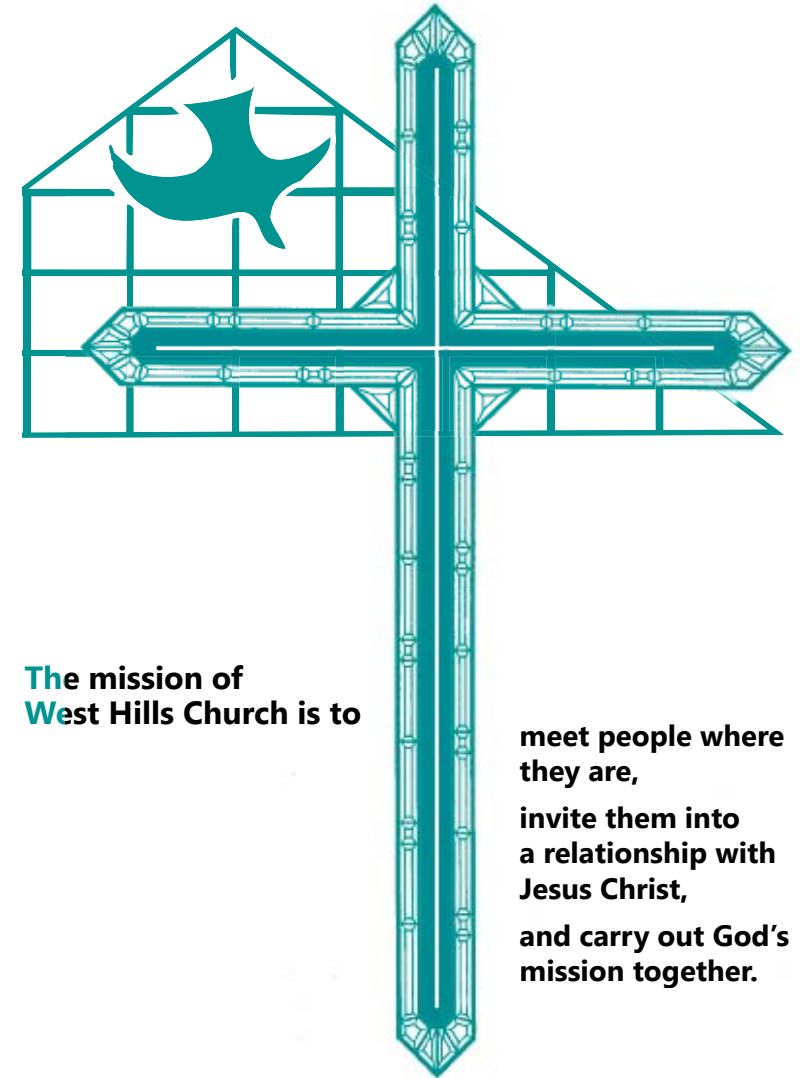

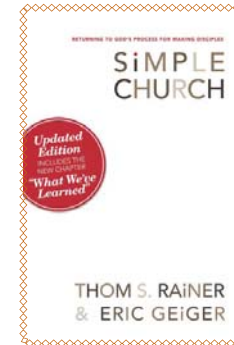
Prayer Pager Ministry
