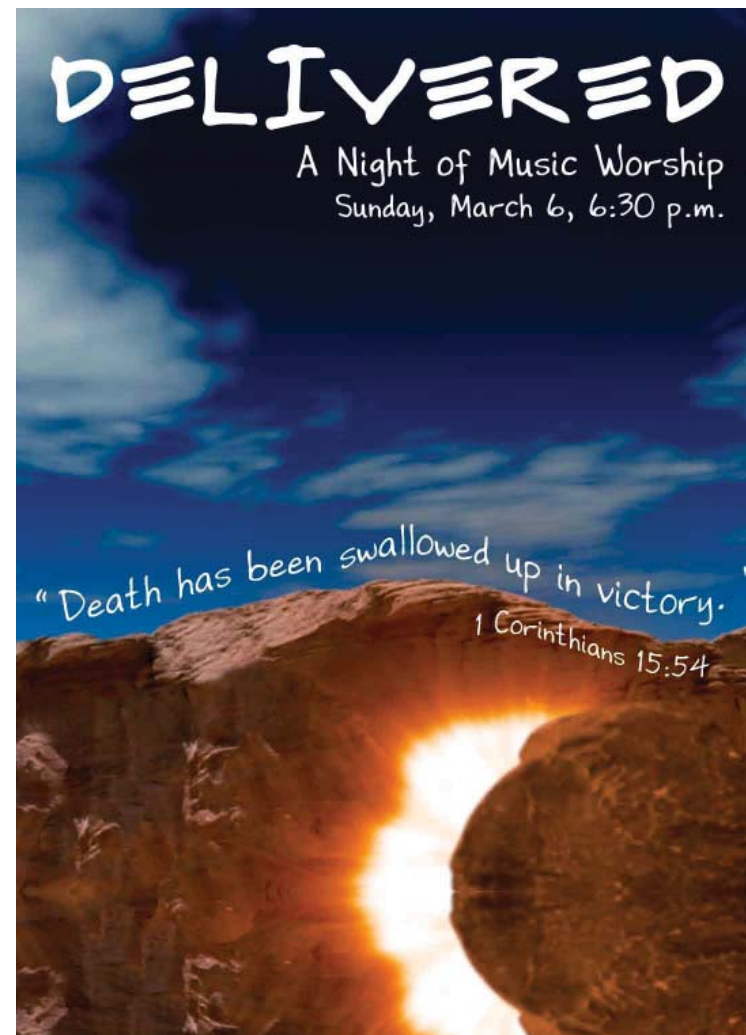
1. When you think of the word young or youth what do you think of? Do you think that you are young? According to the message how old is young?
2. Paul called Timothy to be an example for others believers. Do you think he told Timothy to do this because Timothy was the leader or are we all called to be examples to people? Are you an example, if not, why not?
3. To be an example with our words we must be cautious with what we say and write. When do you find it the most difficult to be an example with your words? What is one thing you or your group could do to help you when you struggle with using words inappropriately?
4. We are also called to be an example or to set a pattern with our behavior and conduct. What type of conduct do you think Paul means? What conduct is appropriate and what is inappropriate for a follower of Jesus? What do you do when you meet another follower of Jesus who has a different definition of what appropriate conduct is? Do you need to adjust your conduct in any area of your life?
5. Love often calls into mind other emotions and feelings. What other emotions or words do you think of when you hear the word love? Is love a matter of the heart or a matter of the will? When is it difficult to love people? Does Jesus want us to love people only when it is convenient or also when it is difficult? What did Jesus mean when he said, "Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you?"
6. Define the word faith? When do we find it hard to have faith? Who is an example of faith to you in your life? Are you an example of faith to anyone?
7. Paul also exhorts us to be an example to people in purity. What do you think he means by purity? What does he not mean? Do we always, sometimes or never have pure motives when we do things? How can we become more pure?
8. Are you second?
