MESSAGE QUESTIONS

2. Read Galatians 5: 22-25 and I Corinthians 12: 4-11. After reading both texts do your best to determine the difference between the Fruit of the Holy Spirit and the Gifts of the Holy Spirit?
3. The Fruit of the Holy Spirit are Godly characteristics that we should all be developing. Go through the list and quickly define each one. Which fruit are you "best," at living out and which fruit do you struggle with the most?
4. How do we develop or cultivate the Fruit of the Holy Spirit in our lives? Stop and pray that God would help you to cultivate the differing Fruits of the Holy Spirit.
5. Read 1 Corinthians 12: 4-11 and Romans 12: 6-8. Name all the gifts detailed in the passages from 1 Corinthians and Romans. What questions do you have about each gift? What does or does not make sense about each gift?
6. What other facts about the "Gifts of the Holy Spirit," do the passages from 1 Corinthians and Romans give us? Where do we get the gifts? Who gives the gifts? How many gifts do we have?
7. According to the texts what is the purpose of our spiritual gifts? Why are we given them?
8. What, in your opinion, is your spiritual gift or gifts?
9. To take the spiritual inventory gifts test, "google" Wagner Modified Houts Questionnaire. If you need a hard copy of this inventory please contact the church and we will print one out for you.
