

# Message Questions

- 1. How would you define the word humble or humility? Who is the most humble person that you know or have ever met?
- 2. Our culture seems to honor success and self-promotion and not humility; why does our culture seem to look down on humility? What are the negative connotations of humility?
- 3. Read Proverbs 25: 6 7b and Luke 14: 7 11. What in these scripture texts surprises you or strikes your interest?
- 4. In the scripture texts people seemingly try to exalt themselves by sitting in a special place. Have you ever been in a similar situation where someone wants to stand in a certain place or have a special seat of honor or sit next to someone important?
- 5. How do we try to exalt ourselves in our culture? What are the not so obvious ways in which we try to exalt ourselves? (Posting our accomplishments on Facebook? Dropping into a conversation that we received a raise? Showing off a new car? Name dropping? Talking about what we are doing/vacations? etc)
- 6. Why does humility not come naturally to us? Do you struggle with humility? If so, in what ways and in which situations do you struggle with humility the most?
- 7. What are some attitudes or concrete ways that we can try and seek to develop more humility in our lives?
- 8. Why does Jesus want us to be humble? How will humility make our life better?
- 9. What is one thing, one place or one area of your life in which you may be more humble or practice humility this week?
