MESSAGE QUESTIONS

1. What is your favorite movie? What is your favorite movie about the Bible or a spiritual issue?
2. Read the Book of Ruth. Would the Book of Ruth make a good movie; why or why not?
3. In the first verses of the Book of Ruth, Naomi and Ruth experience great hardship. What were those hardships and what hardships have you faced in your life?
4. At the end of Chapter One, Naomi wants to be called by a different name. What is the name? Why does she want to be called this? When have you been bitter with God? How do you feel about Naomi's bitterness toward God?
5. Even though Naomi is bitter she still has a faith in God; how should this inform our faith? Why do people turn away from faith in difficult times?
6. How have you been faithful in your life and in your relationship with God through difficult times? Have you ever felt like giving up in life or in God; when?
7. It is quite amazing that Ruth is the heroine of the story considering that she was a Moabite because they were sworn enemies of Israel. If the Book of Ruth was to be told in today's culture who would be an unlikely heroine? What does Ruth's roll tell us about how God feels about people? Do we always treat people as if they are special to God?
8. In the Book of Ruth, Boaz was a Kinsman-Redeemer for Ruth and thus Naomi. In what ways did he redeem them? In what ways does Jesus redeem us?
9. How does Jesus' redemption of us impact you every day? How should his redemption impact us every day?

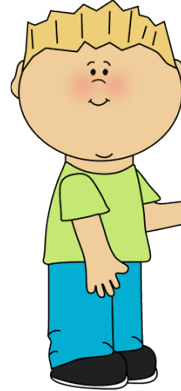
